- ✦ 38,520 hrs on-line
- ✦ 154,000 hrs in-class

G.I.

- ✦ Traditionally In-class
 - ✦ Capacity - 330 members / yr
- ✦ Hybrid (commenced Apr. 2008)
 - ✦ Reduced in-class instructor time by 50%
 - ✦ Reduced student time by 3 days
 - ✦ 16 hrs on-line (no O.T.) replaces 40 hrs in-class
 - ✦ Trained 593 members - Increase of 180%
 - ✦ Continued in 2009 (NO 2 WK COURSES IN 2010)

G.I.

✦ Costs

- ✦ Based on 500 officers
- ✦ 1st yr licence costs (\$72,000) less than in-class costs
 - ✦ \$144 / learner
- ✦ 2nd yr even less (\$24,400)
 - ✦ \$48 / learner
 - ✦ Our charge back cost is \$160 for 2 days of training.
- ✦ Considerably less than sending officers to OPC (\$425,000)
- ✦ Saves TPS 7.5 FTE's

- ✦ > 30,000 hrs on-line
 - ✦ 120,000 hrs in-class
 - ✦ = 125, 1 wk, in-class classes of 24 students
 - ✦ = 625, 1 day, in-class classes of 24 students
 - ✦ = 18 new full time trainers
