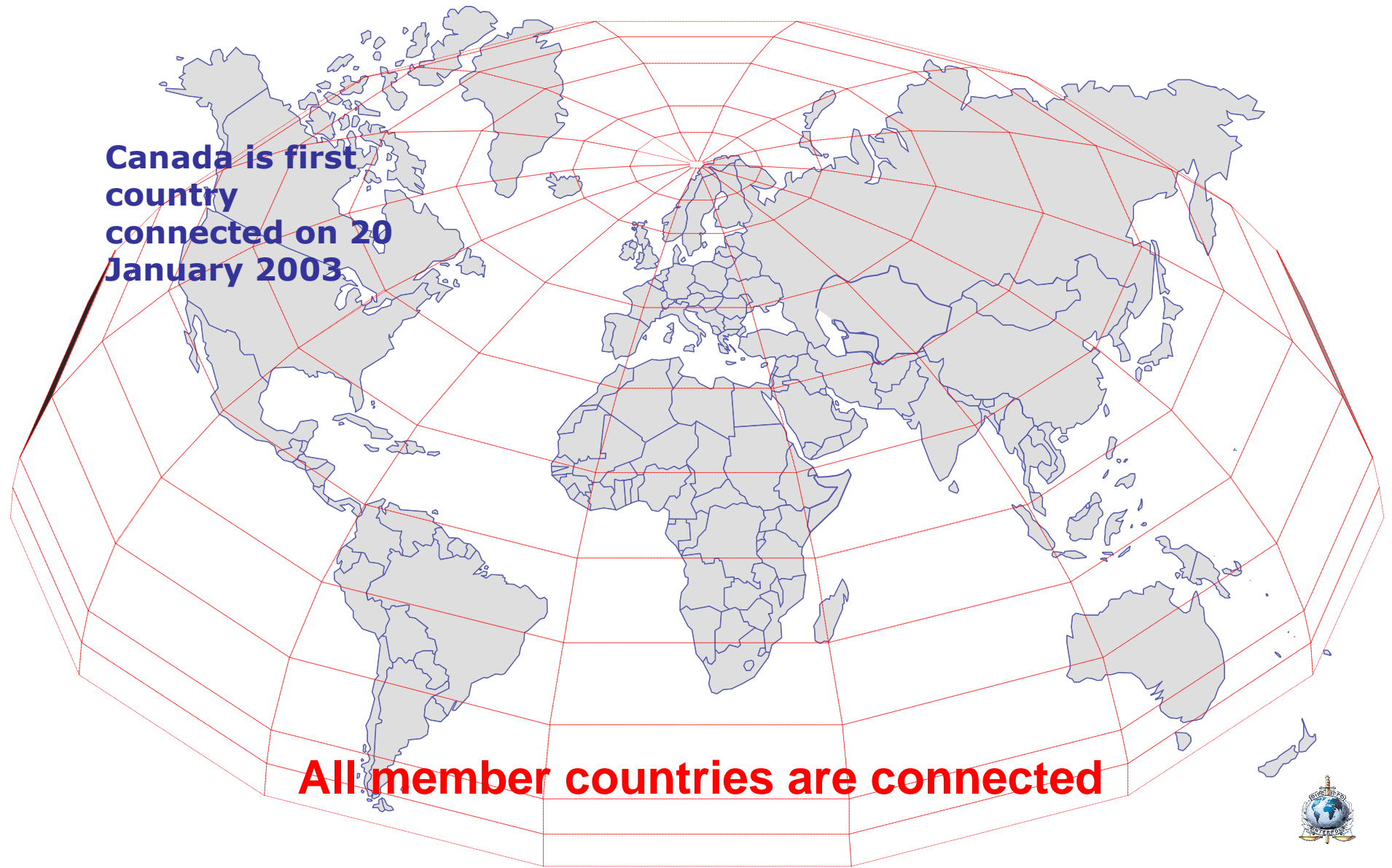


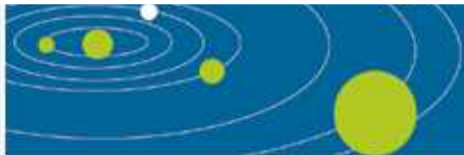
- High-security global police network
