#### **Pilot**

- PTGSC is a pilot project with the Institute for Credible Leadership Development to address a leadership gap for all law enforcement/Compliance and Enforcement agencies.
- Pilot originally for 100 personnel (Now 300)
- Participation includes every agency and multiple ranks
- Independent evaluation by post secondary graduate students

# Environmental Scan of Leadership Training and Education

- Academic programs numerous institutions
- Certificate programs & workshops- numerous
- Online programs few
  - Ontario Police College supervision focus / Ontario specific
  - Vancouver Police supervision focus / Vancouver specific
  - Credible Leadership Phase IV- professional leadership/made in BC



#### Inquiries/ Recommendations

- Oppal (2012) A want of leadership ... stemming from a combination of lack of interest and understanding.
- Schafer's (2010) study of police leaders identified key acts of commission focus on self over others, closed mindedness, micromanagement and acts of omission of poor work ethic, failure to act, poor communication skills, lack of interpersonal skills and lack of integrity as those that contribute to ineffective police leadership stressing the needs for skill based leadership training.

► Closing the GAP Policing and The Community (1994) Recommendation 106 – The Police Academy, in consultation with the Police Training Advisory Committee, develop courses to meet the needs of the middle and senior ranks of management in police agencies. - Program Focuses on:

  - Building high performing teams
  - Reducing complaints and internal investigations
  - Mitigating liabilities
  - Increasing accessibility of leadership training for all officers



- Transforming leadership skills clusters approach
  - Clusters focus on:
    - Personal Mastery/Self-Awareness
    - Interpersonal Communications/Conflict
       Management
    - Problem and Opportunity Management
    - Team and organizational Development
    - Versatility



- Five phase program delivered independently
- Phase IV is based on a behavioural science approach and focusing on the concept that "every officer is a leader"
- Based on the premise that leadership skills are essential
- Interpersonal skill development, professionalism, service orientation and problem solving
- Leadership skills learned, practiced and applied



- Tailored for law enforcement, compliance and enforcement and civilian staff
- "Every one is a leader in the organization" Course is for Admin to Senior Officers
- Online high resolution video format
- Focuses on Competency and Mastery
